



## DISTRICT OF SOOKE

### BYLAW No. 337

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A bylaw to provide a tax exemption for church halls and church land.

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The Council of the District of Sooke in open meeting assembled enacts as follows:

1. This bylaw is cited as *Property Tax Exemption for Church Halls and Church Land Bylaw, 2007*.

#### **Public Worship, Land & Halls**

2. The following lands and improvements are exempt from taxation are hereby declared exempt from taxation pursuant to Sections 220(1)(h), 224(2)(f) and (g) of the *Community Charter*.
  - (a) Lot A, Plan VIP61481, Section 2&3, Sooke Land District, Manufactured Home Reg. #66620 (PID 023-142-391), registered to the Sooke Baptist Church;
  - (b) Lot B, Plan 18924, Section 3, Sooke Land District (PID 003-818-985), registered to the Pentecostal Assemblies of Canada;
  - (c) Lot 1 and B, Plan 1169, Section 3, Sooke Land District, Holy Trinity Anglican Church (PID 007-838-166) registered to Anglican Synod Diocese of BC;
  - (d) Plan 1057, Section PT 10, Sooke Land District, containing .48 Acre more or less being that pcl of land marked church on pl 1057 (lying south of Lot 14) Knox Presbyterian Church (PID 000-108-421) registered to the Presbyterian Church in Canada;
  - (e) Lot 1, Plan 9917, Section 15, Sooke Land District, Church Property (PID 000-349-909) registered to Seventh-Day Adventist Church (British Columbia Conference);
  - (f) Lot 1, Plan 9247, Section 15, Sooke Land District, (PID 000-042-951) registered to Seventh-Day Adventist Church (British Columbia Conference); and

- (g) Lot A, Plan VIP74513, Section 26, Sooke Land District, (PID 025-527-045), registered to Sooke Congregation of Jehovah's Witnesses.
