BYLAW No. 601

A bylaw to establish a Carbon Tax Rebate Reserve Fund.

The Council of the District of Sooke, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw is cited as the Carbon Tax Rebate Reserve Fund Bylaw, 2014.
- 2. A Carbon Tax Rebate Reserve Fund is established for the specified purpose of depositing and using any funds received to support initiatives to reduce carbon emissions in the District of Sooke.
- 3. Each year, any rebate from the Climate Action Revenue Incentive Program received by the District of Sooke must be placed to the credit of the Carbon Tax Rebate Reserve Fund.
- 4. Money in the Carbon Tax Rebate Reserve Fund, and interest earned on it, must be used only for the purpose of funding initiatives to reduce carbon emissions within the District of Sooke.
