



Homeowner Plumbing Installations

Property owners wishing to install plumbing in their own place of residence must provide an isometric showing the proposed layout with their application for Plumbing Permit.

The purpose of this isometric is to enable the Plumbing Inspector to check the intended installation so that correction may be made before the plumbing is installed. Having an isometric drawing checked by the plumbing inspector first will help the homeowner in doing the installation correctly and also alleviate additional inspections being made by the Municipal Inspector.

This requirement is in compliance with Building Bylaw 70 and the current edition of the BC Plumbing Code.
