## DISTRICT OF SOOKE

## BYLAW No. 58

A bylaw to authorize officers, employees and agents of the municipality to enter on property and to serve summonses.

Under the authority of section 268 of the *Local Government Act* and section 28 of the *Offence Act*, the Council of the District of Sooke, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw is cited as the *Authority to Enter Property Bylaw*, 2001.
- 2. The persons appointed to the position of Building Inspector, Municipal Planner, Municipal Engineer, Fire Chief, Deputy Fire Chief and Bylaw Enforcement Officer are authorized to enter at all reasonable times on any property to ascertain whether any regulations, directions or bylaws of the Council are being observed.
- The persons appointed to the position of Animal Control Officer are authorized to enter at all reasonable times on any property to ascertain whether any regulations, directions or bylaws of the Council relating to the regulation of Animals are being observed.
- 4. The persons appointed to the positions of Bylaw Enforcement Officer, Building Inspector and Animal Control Officer are granted the authority to serve a summons in the manner prescribed in section 28 of the *Offence Act*.
- 5. By-law No. 9, 1999, "District of Sooke Authority to Enter Property By-law 9, 1999" is repealed.
