A bylaw to establish a reserve fund for the Sooke Program for the Arts (SPA).

Under section 188 of the *Community Charter* a Council may, by bylaw, establish a reserve fund for a specified purpose and direct that money be placed to the credit of the reserve fund.

The Council of the District of Sooke, in open meeting assembled, enacts as follows:

- 1. This Bylaw is cited as Sooke Program for the Arts (SPA) Reserve Fund Bylaw, 2004. (amended by Bylaw No. 233 November 14, 2005)
- 2. A Sooke Program for the Arts (SPA) Reserve Fund is established. (amended by Bylaw No. 233 November 14, 2005)
- 3. Each year, general funds equivalent to 3% of the building permit fees received in the previous year must be placed to the credit of the Sooke

Program for the Arts (SPA) Reserve Fund. (amended by Bylaw No. 233 November 14, 2005) (amended further by Bylaw No. 409 June 15, 2009)

4. Money in the Sooke Program for the Arts (SPA) Reserve Fund, and interest earned on it, must be used only for the purpose of public art projects approved by Council." (amended by Bylaw No. 233 November 14, 2005) (amended by Bylaw No. 553 October 22, 2012)
